**I. Call to Order** by President Mike Lynch at 1810 hrs.

#### d. Pink Bear Project – Bernardo

Tom said that the amount was around \$1,970.66. Mike stated that he was going to send a supplemental donation to make the total \$2,000.66. Mike further stated that since this is the  $5^{th}$  or  $6^{th}$  year for Pink Bear that the total raised is about \$20,000 but that he didn't have the actual figure in front of him. Mike reminded everyone that none of the amount came from the Foundation.

### e. World Ranger Day. -- Jeff

Planning is on-going and went on to explain some of the things that NPS is planning to do.

Jeff further stated that East Bay Regional Park District has agreed to sponsor World Ranger Day in 2024. The Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) has agreed to supplying a medal to present to the family.

#### **MOTION** by Ann Meneguzzi

That the Foundation allot up to \$700 to support World Ranger Day at Pt. Reyes National Seashore on July 31, 2023.

#### **MOTION APPROVED** – unanimously.

### f. **Alpine Club Lodge** – Ann Meneguzzi

Ann explained that she has no control over the Lodge because it is controlled by a board of trustees, and they are confused over what they should do concerning COVID restrictions. Ann asked what was desired, and Mike suggested renting the Lodge for two nights (Saturday and Sunday nights) with the idea of having a CSPRA in-person Board meeting on Sunday and leaving on Monday to attend the World Ranger Day. Ann stated that she will talk to Amy (the trustee chair) about the possibility.

#### g. World Ranger Congress – Mike

Mike gave an update of what is happening with the World Ranger Federation. There won't be a Congress in 2023 and there are several countries that are putting in a bid for 2024.

#### h. Coronavirus Grants - Mike

Haven't had any applications recently and Mike expressed the thought that the whole program is probably winding down.

#### i. Equipment Grants

### j. Visitor Services Training Account - Tom

Very little money in the account. The current class hasn't approached the Foundation to let us know what they want to do with the money left over from the previous class.
